





I am an Ethiopian native born on November 2, 1957 in Dire Dawa south west Ethiopia. After I completed my high school program, I joined the "Ecole Technique Superior" in February 1979. Later in September 1984, I graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Urbanism. Later in November 1986, I attended a training technology in France.

I was working in the Municipality of Addis Ababa and non-governmental organizations, like care, concern Catholic mission SIM (with my profession civil engineer work). I served the people by running as an independent candidate for a seat in the Addis Ababa Municipality council.

With the relentless call of the people for a free and democratic government, the military Derg. Regime unleashed the "Red Terror" campaign that killed close to 150,000 people in a matter of months. Thus, I lived under fear the "Revolutionary Guard". I resumed my professional job under the Addis Abebe Municipality and found that the alleviation of the standard of living of the town inhabitants should be given priority.


I worked on a team of experts overseen by the "project office for the Creation of Small Scale business opportunities, which constructed small kiosks (store) parking lots and bethes stations to be rented to poor people.

After I left the country, I was informed that the police had sent me summons to appear for "investigation". I have been through a lot due to my political opinion. My hope of living a peaceful and fruitful life has been shattered. I was arrested and beaten for my political attitudes and ethnic the background considering the pain and the suffering I have undergone, I plead to the United States government that I be granted political asylum in order to be able to start living.

In November 2, 2004 I got the U.S. Home Inspection Certificate from Chantilly, Virginia. After I worked a lot, my ZCompanies LLC, established on January 14, 2005. And my home improvement contractor license issued in January 1, 2007 and Maryland License on August 1, 2007. I believe under the DC Office of Local Business Development LSDBE set aside program, we can continue to provide the government with quality technical services of the same or better caliber as provide by big companies at far less cost, thereby resulting in significant savings to the DC Government. We have already demonstrated that by being in the program for the past three years, and have performed on many small contracts to our customer (the respective DC Agency's) satisfaction furthermore, I believe that the LSDBE program will shelter me from being discriminated and provide the opportunity a fair share and access of contracting opportunities within the government. I also pledge to dedicate my Z Companies LLC to be free of social and economic injustice to all our employees regardless of color, race, creed, religion or lifestyle.

Thank you for having us in LSDBE program and sincerely hope you will approve our application, so that we may compete for DC Government contracts under LSDBE umbrella.


